track championship in 2001.

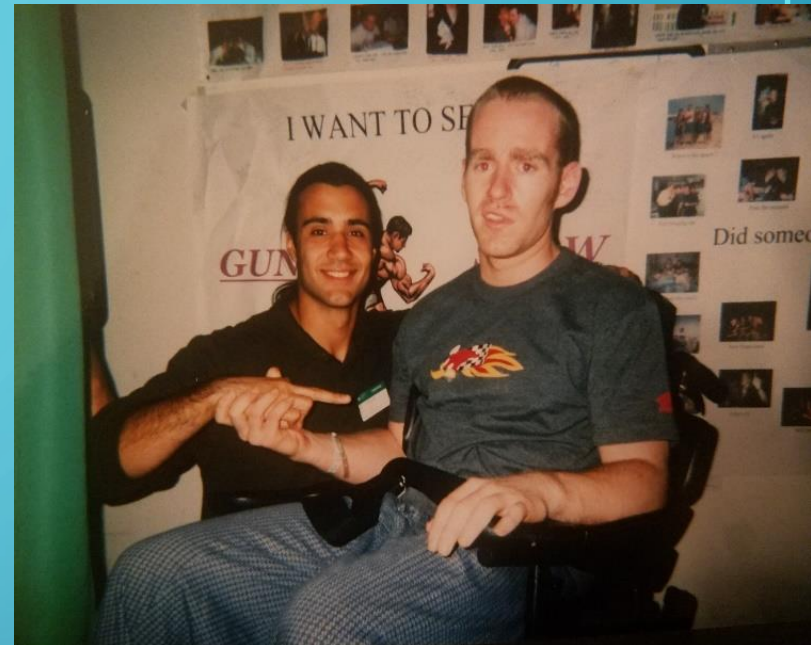

Dr. John spent the next 6 months rehabbing from a traumatic brain injury.

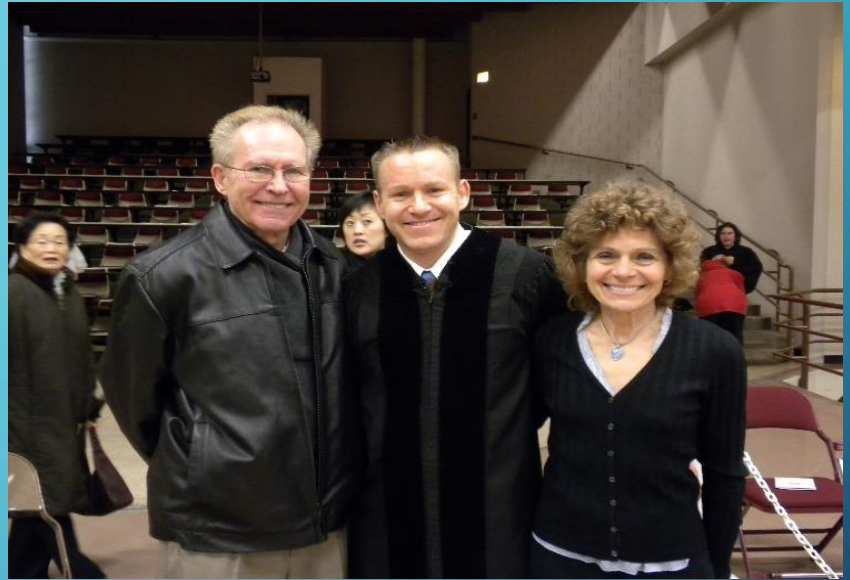




# MAKING A DIFFERENCE
